

Balanced e-Governance



e-Democracy

- One-way communication from government to citizens
- Two-way interaction between governments, NGOs and citizens
- Active participation, direct contribution by NGOs and citizens



How to measure e-Democracy?

- 1) e-Readiness national and international surveys
- 2) Strategic and legal frameworks main strategies and action plans
- 3) Institutions and actors governmental institutions and stakeholders involved
- 4) e-Democracy showcases most prominent implementations of e-democracy



Barriers



- Lack of comprehensive national surveys on egovernance and ereadiness
- "open data is a sleeping beauty"
- Poor cooperation and coordination

Triggers



- OGP as driving force
- Combination of online- and offlineactivities
- Local level activism boosts general eactivism




Participatory Budgeting





Values of PB in Tartu

- Flexibility and dynamism, readiness for risk




Idea map used for Tartu Comprehensive Plan 2030+
